Fees include a \$25 non-refundable deposit per week/child. Limited Subsidy is available.

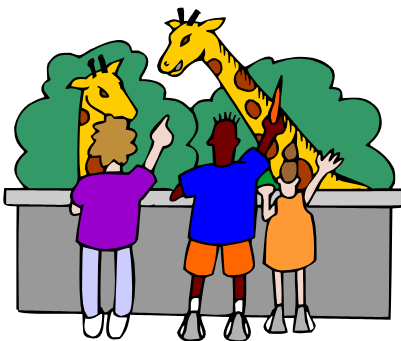
Before care (8 - 9 a.m.): \$15/week/child

Registration Information

Regular Fees:

\$100 per child/week if registered by May 12

\$125 per child/week for any registration after May 12

(\$25.00 non-refundable deposit/week required per child to reserve your spot)

Before & After Care Fees:

8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. (before care – \$15/wk/child)

5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (after care – \$15/wk/child)

Full payment is DUE:

➤ **June 15** for all camp weeks in JULY

➤ **July 13** for all camp weeks in AUGUST

(If you need an alternate payment schedule, please contact the Program Director, May Seto before June 9.)

➤ **Refunds, less the non-refundable \$25 deposit, are only available with 10 calendar days notice.**

Camp Information

Lunches: Please send a **NUT-FREE** lunch and a drink every day.
Lunches **are not refrigerated** (mayonnaise and lunch meats can spoil quickly) and glass bottles and containers should be avoided.

Behaviour: Serious behaviour such as kicking, punching, racial slurs and verbal/physical threats **are completely unacceptable at our camp**. Continued acting out may result in suspension for the rest of the summer.

Late Fees: Pick up is no later than 5:00 p.m. for regular hours and 6:00 p.m. for after care participants. **(Late fees will apply at a rate of \$1/per minute.)**
