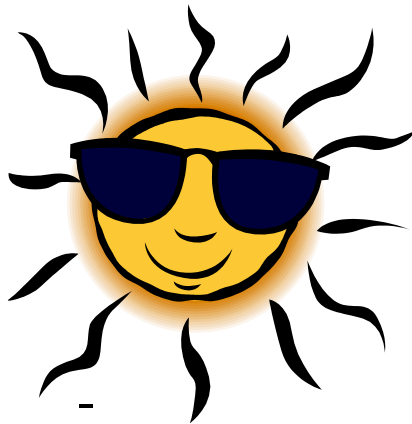

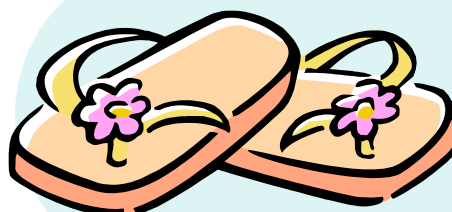
Earlybird Rate (by May 12) - **\$200**

Applegrove Summer Leadership Program

Applegrove is pleased to offer our summer leadership program for young teens.

Trained staff will provide a safe, secure and structured environment where teens ages 12 to 15 can develop their own potential, self-confidence and sense of responsibility. This is accomplished through a variety of social, educational, cultural and recreational activities, including placements within Applegrove. Some Leaders-in-Training will work with children in our day camp; others may work with children up to age 6 in Applegrove's Parent/Child program or help out with office tasks and outreach.

The first week of each session will focus on training. The second week will focus on placements. Teens enrolled in all sessions will have the opportunity to learn different skills and engage with their peers.

Registration Information

Fees: Earlybird rate by May 12 - \$200 per 2 week session
Regular rate after May 12 - \$250.00 per participant per 2-week session
(*\$50.00 **non-refundable** deposit per child per week due upon registration)

Full payment is DUE:

- **June 15** for sessions 1 & 2
- **July 13** for session 3
(If you need an alternate payment schedule, please contact the Program Director, May Seto before June 9.)
- **Refunds, less the non-refundable \$50 deposit, are only available with 10-calendar days notice.**

Camp Information

Hours: 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Lunches: Please send a **NUT-FREE lunch** and a drink every day. Lunches **are not refrigerated** (mayonnaise and lunch meats can spoil quickly) and glass bottles and containers should be avoided.

Swimming: Send a swimsuit and towel every day and please let staff know if your child is afraid of water or cannot swim. Sending sunscreen, a hat and sunglasses will also protect your child from the sun, since they may spend a great deal of time outdoors.

Events: Special workshops may include **Babysitting** and **First Aid** and will be offered in specific sessions.

Behaviour: Serious behaviours such as kicking, punching, racial slurs and verbal/physical threats **are completely unacceptable at our centre**. Continuous acting out may result in suspension for the rest of the summer.
