Income Tax Clinic

March 1 - April 26

Wednesdays 9:30 am - 4:30 pm by appointment only (in-person or virtual)

Need help completing your taxes? See if you are eligible for our free tax clinic.

You are eligible if you:

- Are a single person with an income of \$35,000 or less
- Are a 2-person family with an income of \$40,000 or less
- Are an individual with a dependent with an income of \$35,000 or less
- Have an interest income of no more than \$1,000
- Have a simple, straightforward return, with income from basic employment, social assistance, or pension
- Do NOT have capital gains, rental or self-employed income
- Need only the 2022 tax year prepared
