Connect with your baby through yoga. Hosted by Laurie, this class is ideal for babies up to the age of 1 year, but all are welcome to participate.

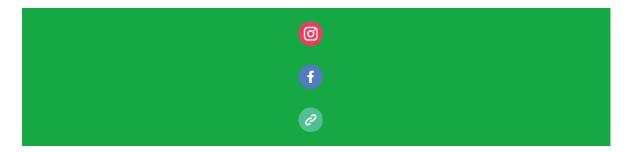
Next session: Tuesday, April 8, 1 PM at Woodfield (Duke of Connaught Public School).
