POSITION SUMMARY

Leadership Counsellors will be responsible for planning, implementing activities, workshops, excursions and special events for youth ages 12-15 years.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

Working as part of a team, to:

- Plan and implement a Leadership Program that develops team building and life skills, self-esteem, and self-confidence
- Ensure the safety of participants at all times
- Organize Leadership excursions and special events
- Provide direction and mentorship to program volunteers
- Supervision of participants in placement opportunities within the summer camp programs
- Conduct evaluation of Summer Leadership participants
- Book speakers or facilitators as needed for planned workshops
- Communicate and coordinate with other on-site programs, as appropriate
- Keep Camp Coordinator and Child & Youth Coordinator informed on participant progress, issues and concerns
- Provide support to the Summer Camp Program as directed
